We visit a lot of new buildings eg. in the harbour area The Wave by Henning Larsen Architects and the Kirk domicil by Olufur Eliasson, urban space and parks and hear about the city strategy of Vejle. We visit the Citylab, which is unique in Denmark as an exhibiton for the city development. We visit the UNESCO Heritage area Jelling, where the vikings founded Denmark.

We meet the city architect of Vejle and representatives from the city council.

Day 3

Before noon we will visit social housing ares and innovation hubs in Vejle.
